At the meeting of Atherstone Town Council held on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup>. April 2015 the Town Council considered the recent planning consultations:

PAP/2015/0132, Warwick House Ratcliffe Street, Atherstone, CV9 1JP – replacement of existing windows and doors with grey aluminium windows.

It was resolved that the Town Council had no objection to the solution approved by the Civic Society.

PAP/2015/0128, Alder Mill Business Park, Sheepy Road, Atherstone, CV9 3AH.

Demolition of 2 bays of existing glasshouses and erection of storage building.

It was resolved that the Town Council objected to this application, on the grounds of over-intensification, and the belief that this is a retrospective application. The site is also positioned on a dangerous bend.

PAP/2015/0195, 2 & 6 Westwood Road, 8 & 12 Slacks Avenue, 18 Stratford Avenue, 60 Westwood Crescent, Installation of external wall insulation to all elevations.

It was resolved that there was no objection to this application.

PAP/2015/0220, 81 Witherley Road, Atherstone, CV9 1NA.

Works to fell 2 trees protected by a tree preservation order.

It was resolved that the Town Council objected to this application, if the trees were healthy, and should be subject to an arboriculturalist's report.

PAP/2015/0110 & 0113, The Angel Inn, 24 Church Street, Atherstone – part demolition of rear extension. Construction of 1 small retail unit and first floor storage. Erection of 5 pairs of 2 bedroom semi-detached dwellings & 2 one bedroom flats, with associated access ways and bin store and fencing. Also conservation area consent. It was resolved that the Town Council objected to this application on the grounds of over intensification of the area, and changes to the streetscene.

PAP/2015/0182 – 189 Long Street, Atherstone, change of use to beauty salon. It was resolved that the Town Council had no objection to this application.
