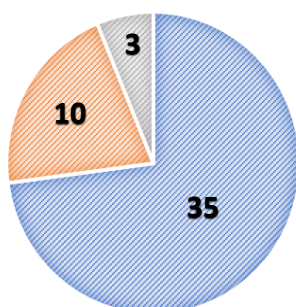


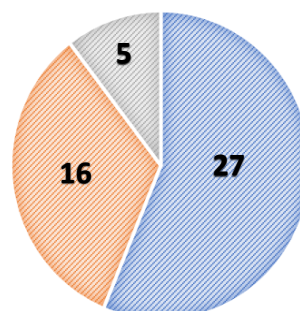
Did you understand the reason for the benches being moved?

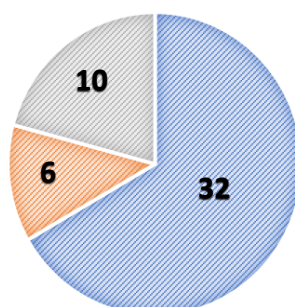
Did you agree with the benches being removed?

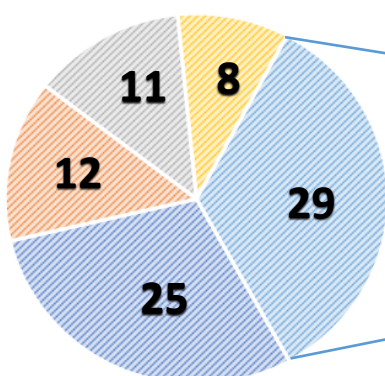
Would you like to see the benches relocated?

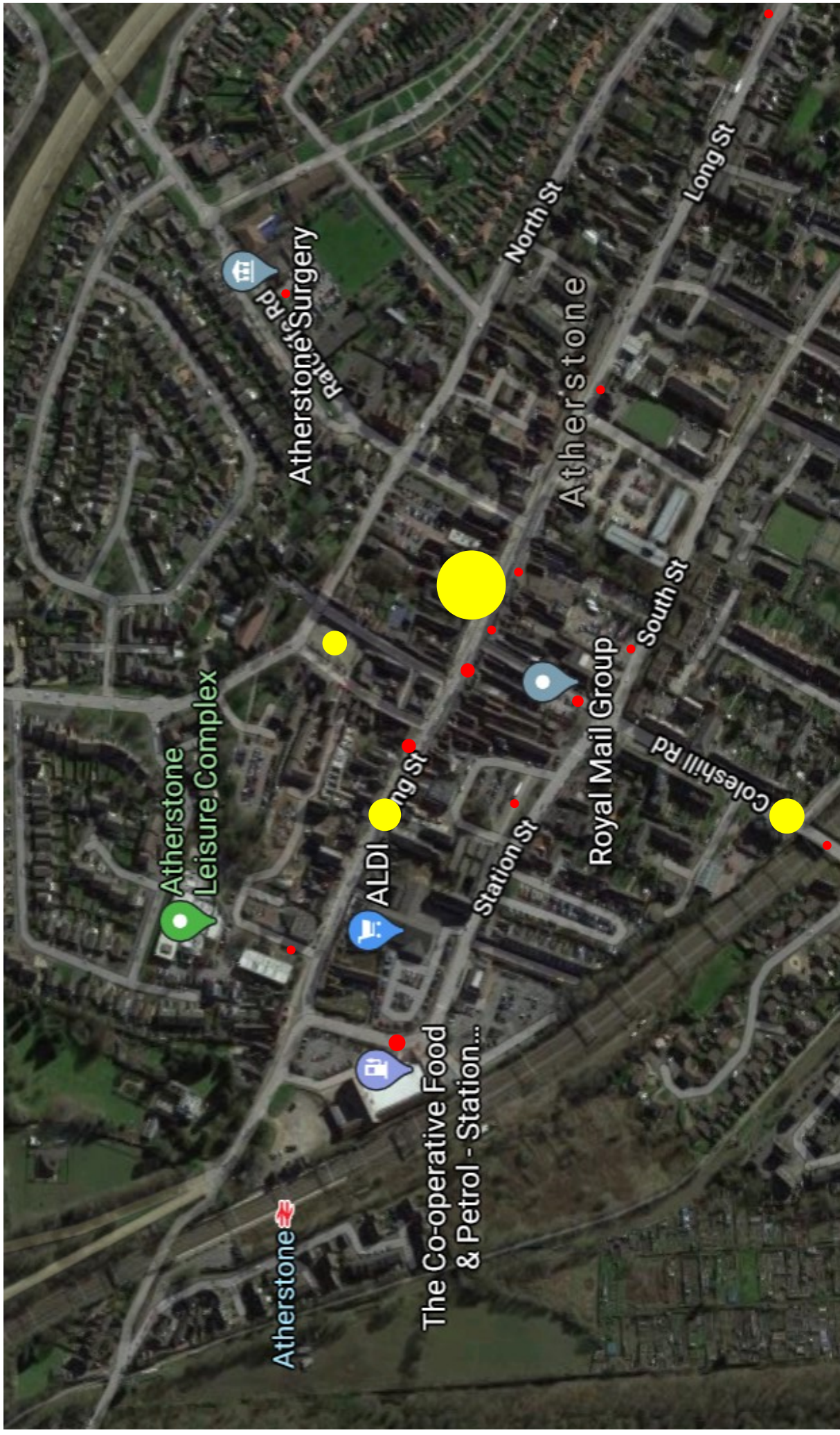


* Chart includes locations suggested 2 or more times. Locations suggested by one individual were:
