The Town Council has finalised its budget for 2016-17 and has set a Precept of £134,691.

In addition the Council will receive a Council Tax Support Grant of £17,672.
This has been achieved by taking funds from the general reserves to support the budget requirements, and has resulted in an increase in the charge for a Band "D" property of 2.03% giving an actual increase of £1.02 for each property.
