Burglary (business) – 2. <ul style="list-style-type: none">Business premises broken into. One took place on Holly Lane, the other on Carlyon Road Burglary (dwelling) – 1. 	<p>Other Inc's/news</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A prolific offender from the area has been arrested and charged and remanded in custody in relation to 2 x burglaries in North Warwickshire area and is due in Court in April. • Following a joint visit to a business premises on Ratcliffe Road, two males were identified as being in UK illegally and were arrested for immigration offences and a quantity of cannabis seized. • A Criminal Behaviour Order has now been issued to a nuisance male who frequents the town centre.
